Roy E. "Ed" Craig, 84, of Vandalia, passed away on Tuesday, August 25, 2015 at his home in Vandalia.

Services for Ed will be held at 10:30am, Friday, August 28, 2015 at the First Church of God, Thrill Hill Rd., Vandalia with Pastor Tom Farris officiating. Visitation will be held one hour prior to services at the church. Burial will follow in Griffith Cemetery, Brownstown.
