**E**thel Marie Jackson, 98, of Vandalia, passed away at 10:35pm, Friday, February 14, 2014 at Fayette County Hospital Long Term Care.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00am, Thursday, February 20, 2014 at Mother of Dolours Catholic Church in Vandalia with Rev. Fr. Barry Harmon officiating. Visitation will be held from 9:00-11:00am, Thursday, February 20, 2014 prior to the service at Mother of Dolours Catholic Church, Vandalia. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Cemetery, Ramsey, IL. Memorials may be made to Mother of Dolours Catholic Church or Memorial Masses may be made.
