Kay Cearlock Kistler, 73, of Vandalia passed away at 11:55pm, Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at her home in Vandalia.

Services will be held at 10:00am, Saturday, December 13, 2014 at Temple Baptist Church, Vandalia with Rev. Harry Kirk officiating. Visitation will be held from 5:00-7:00pm, Friday, December 12, 2014 at Temple Baptist Church, Vandalia and 1 hour prior to services Saturday at the church. Burial will follow in Fairlawn Cemetery, Vandalia. Memorials may be made to Shriners Hospitals for Children.

Kay was born September 30, 1941, in Vandalia, the daughter of John Franklin and Opal Irene (Elder) Cearlock.
