Tommy J. "Tom" Philpot, 77, of Vandalia passed away at 5:15am, Friday, April 3, 2015 at Memorial Medical Center Springfield.

Services will be held at 11:00am, Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at the First Pentecostal Church in Vandalia with Pastor Daniel McDonald and Pastor Tom Fedrigo officiating. Visitation will be held from 5:00-7:00pm, Monday, April 6, 2015 at the First Pentecostal Church in Vandalia and 1 hour prior to services Tuesday at the church.
