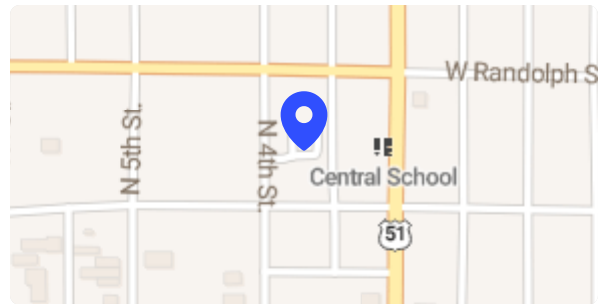

He was preceded in death by his parents and infant son Nolan F. Branham.






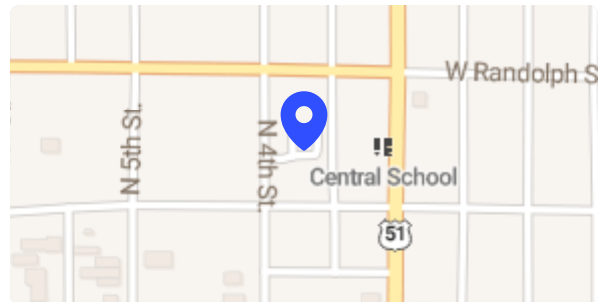

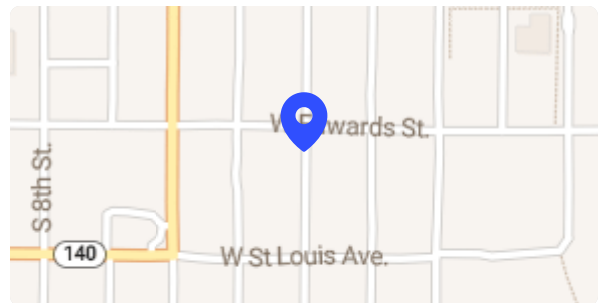
