Mariece Ann Pryor "Sparky" finished the good race and went to be with the Lord, Saturday, October 21, 2017; she passed peacefully at home surrounded by those she loved.

A Celebration to Honor her life will be held at 1:00pm, Thursday, October 26, 2017 at Hohlt & File Funeral Home, Vandalia with Pastor Larry Morris officiating. Visitation will be held from 11:00am-1:00pm, prior to services at the funeral home. Burial will follow at Farmers Cemetery, rural Shobonier. In lieu of flowers memorials may be made to the family of Sparky Pryor or to the American Cancer Society.

Together they raised three children. Mariece worked as a Certified Nurse's Assistant for several years and worked at Big O's BBQ in Centralia.

She was a member of the New Destiny Church of God in Centralia and was an ordained evangelist; she loved traveling and sharing the gospel, encouraging people through her faith. She was a true inspiration to everyone she met, never knowing a stranger; her faith was unshakeable in her battle against cancer. Mariece loved life and lived it to the fullest, she was a gifted writer, and shared her faith through her poems, it brought joy, strength, and laughter to many people, a true testimony of Christ's love.
