Mary Louise Robinson, 86, of Vandalia, Illinois passed away on Sunday, January 7, 2018 at Fayette County Hospital.

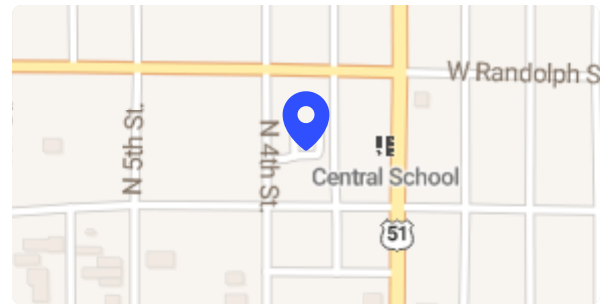

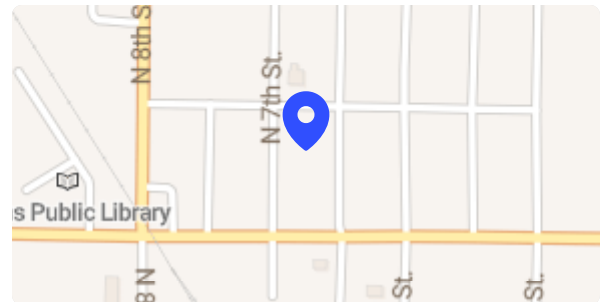

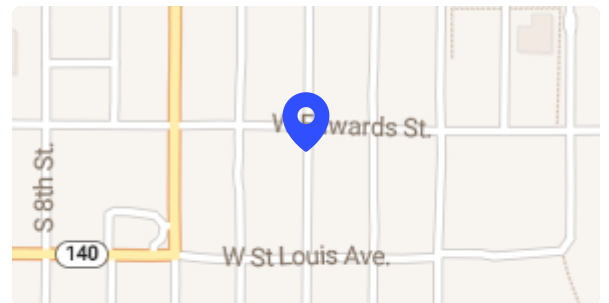
