He was preceded in death by his parents, Vincent and Louella DuFaux.

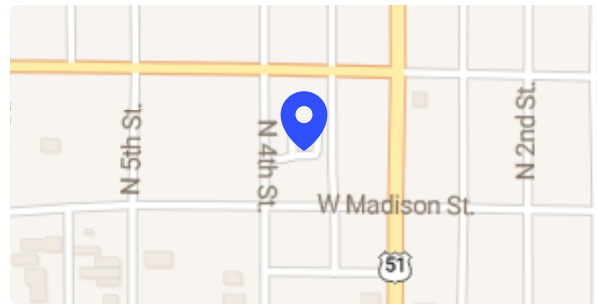
