She was preceded in death by her parents; husbands; siblings, Vera, Bob, Mary, Russell, and Faye; and a great-grandson, Carter.



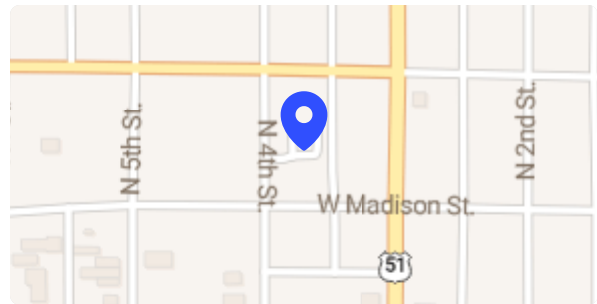

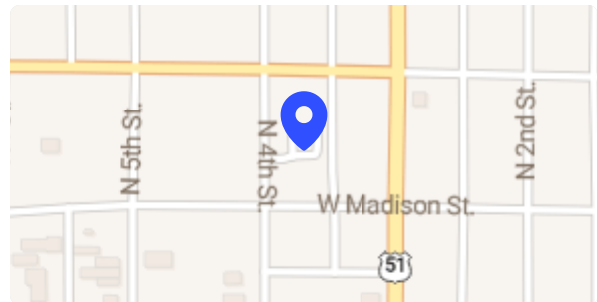

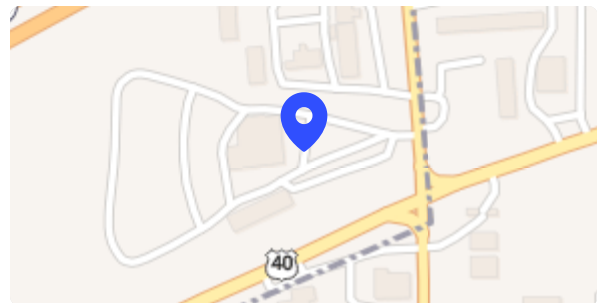
