She was preceded in death by her mother; husband; and a grandson, Wesley Tinker.






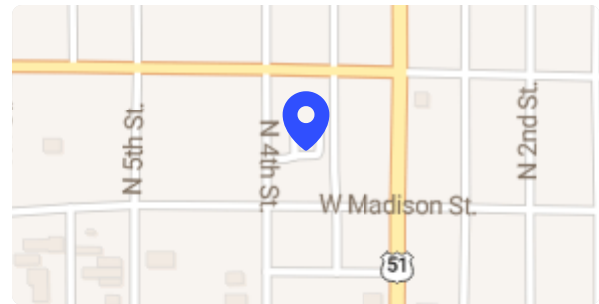

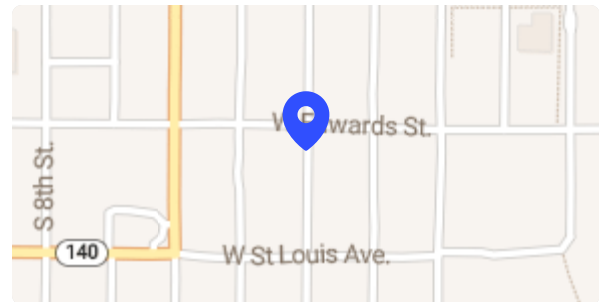

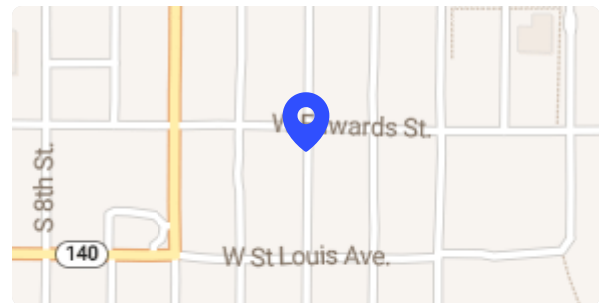
