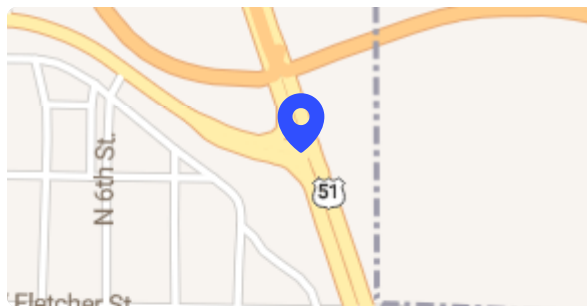

She was preceded in death by her parents; son, David Keppler; granddaughter, Monica Kistler; and great-granddaughter, Kayley DeFreese.






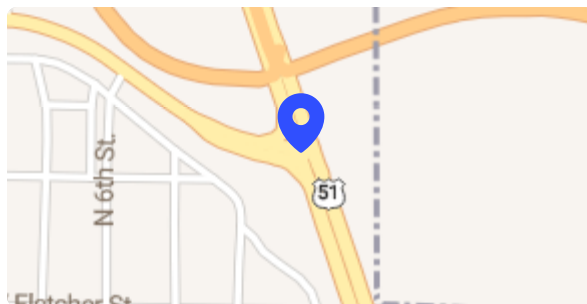

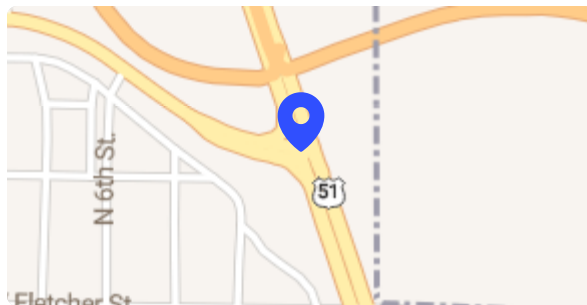

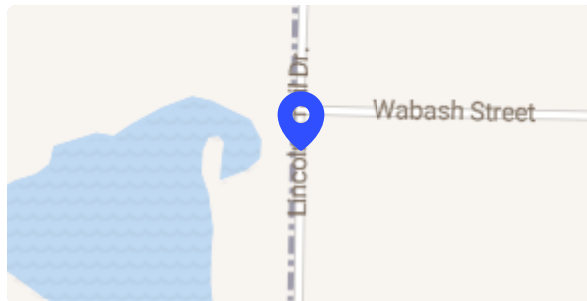
