**G**wendolyn A. Caldwell, 91, of Vandalia, IL passed away at 8:05 PM, Friday, January 25, 2019 at Willowbrook Memory Care in Vandalia.

A Funeral Service will be held at 11:00 AM, Saturday, February 2, 2019 at The First Presbyterian Church in Vandalia with Reverend Kurt Simon officiating. Interment will follow at Zion Grove Cemetery, Kell, IL. Visitation will be held prior to services from 9:00-11:00 AM, Saturday, February 2, 2019 at The First Presbyterian Church. Gwendolyn A. Caldwell was born on March 23, 1927 in Farina, IL, the daughter of Harry and Frieda (Bauman) Crosley. She married John R. 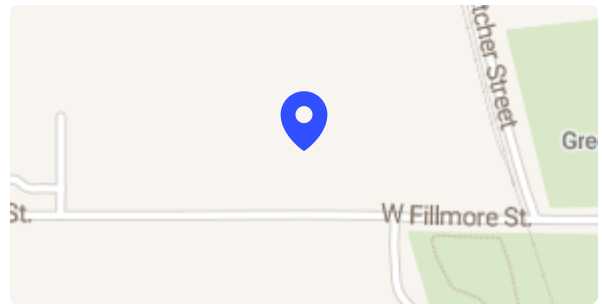

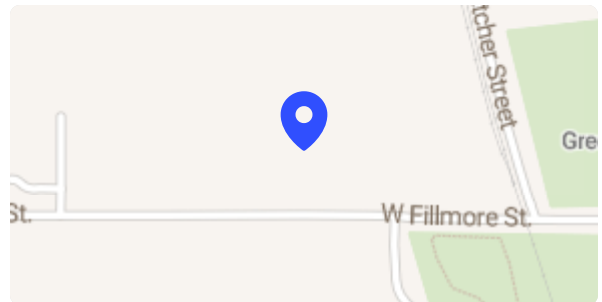

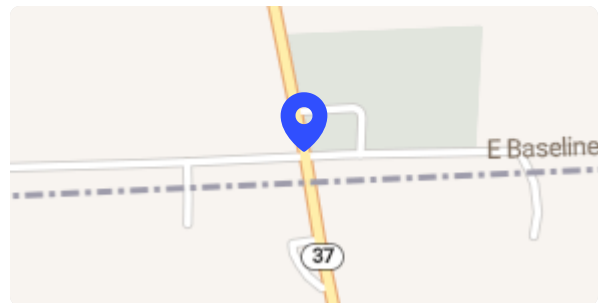
