Jeffrey Craig “Izzy” Isringhausen, 54, of Vandalia, IL passed away at 5:36pm, Saturday, February 16, 2019 at St. Anthony’s Memorial Hospital in Effingham.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 1:00 PM, Thursday, February 21, 2019 at Mother of Dolors Catholic Church, Vandalia with Rev. Fr. Scott Snider officiating. Interment will follow in Fairlawn Cemetery, Vandalia. Visitation will be held from 4:00-8:00 PM, Wednesday, February 20, 2019 at Mother of Dolors.
