**J**ames Todd McKellar, 85, of Vandalia, IL passed away at 7:35 PM, Monday, February 25, 2019 at Fayette County Hospital.

A Funeral Service will be held at 11:00 AM, Monday, March 04, 2019 at the First Presbyterian Church, Vandalia with Rev. Kurt Simon officiating. Interment will follow in Fairlawn Cemetery, Vandalia. Visitation will be held from 3:00-6:00 PM, Sunday, March 03, 2019 at the First Presbyterian Church and one hour prior to services on Monday from 10:00-11:00 AM. James Todd McKellar was born on October 01, 1933 in Vandalia, IL, the son of Donald and Gladys (Mettler) McKellar. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Kay Cameron.






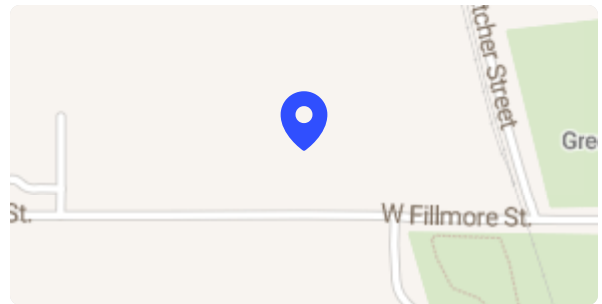
