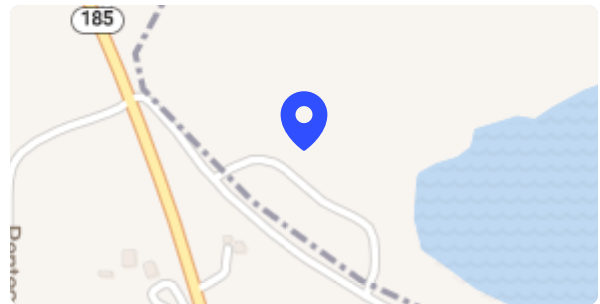

She was preceded in death by her parents and son-in-law Jeffrey Isringhausen.



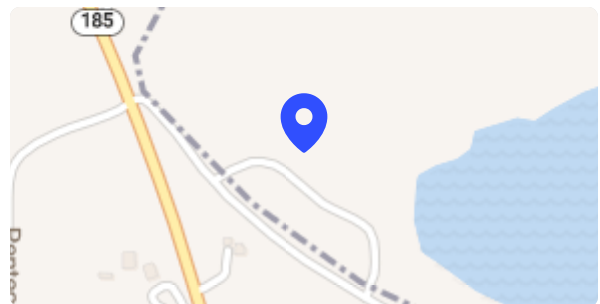

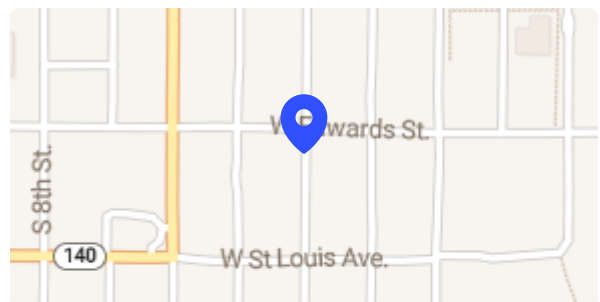
