He was preceded in death by his parents and daughter, LeighAnn Macks.

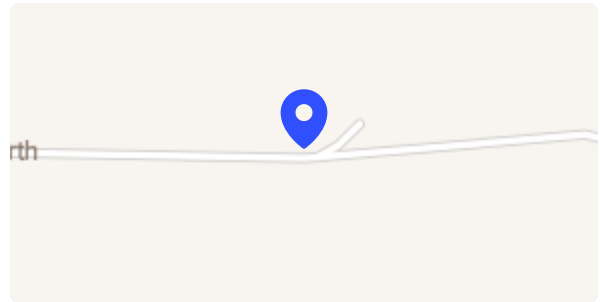

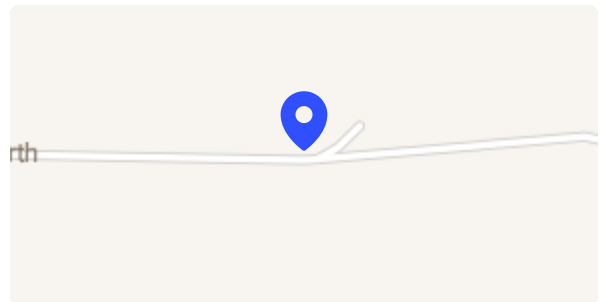
