Preceded in death by his parents; son, Jeremy Mosley; and daughter, Cori Mosley.

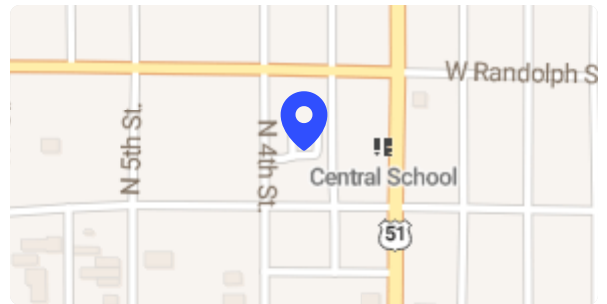
