She was preceded in death by her mother, Marjorie Fisher; sister, Elaine Fisher; brothers, Jim Fisher and Dave Fisher.






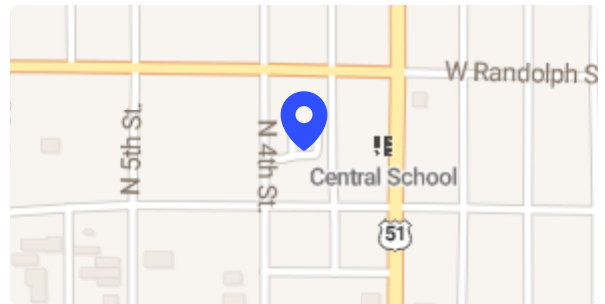

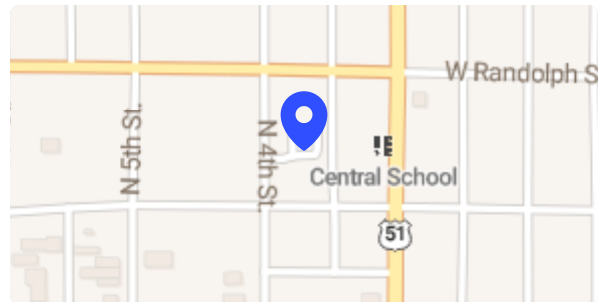

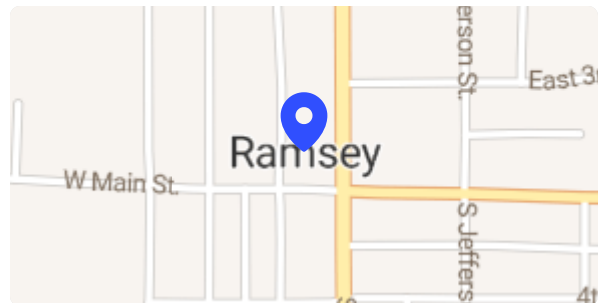
