He was preceded in death by his adoptive parents, Edward and Ellen Black and a son, Zeppelin Black.






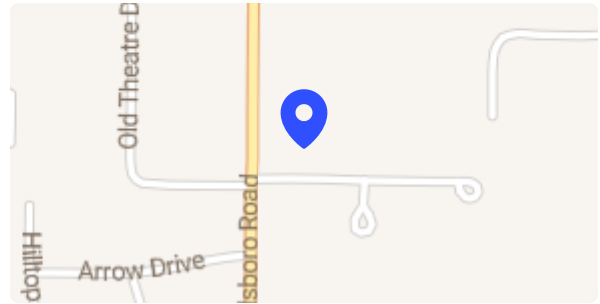

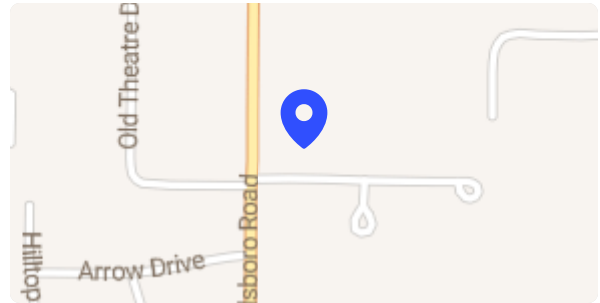

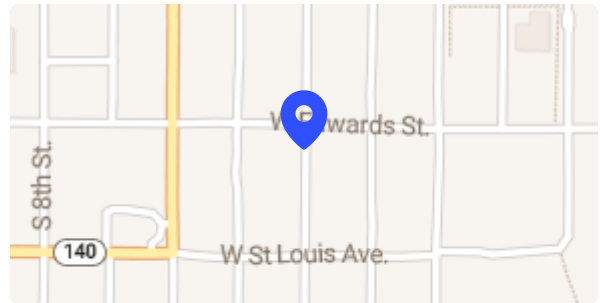
