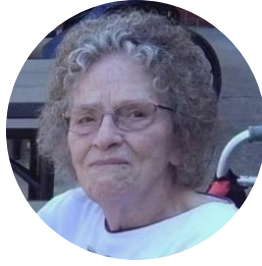

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; brother, Lewis Leininger; and sisters, Genevieve Mattix and Bertha Mobley.






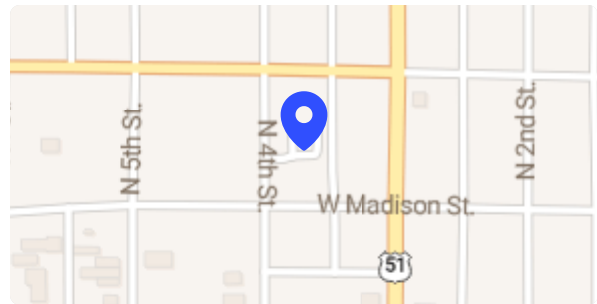

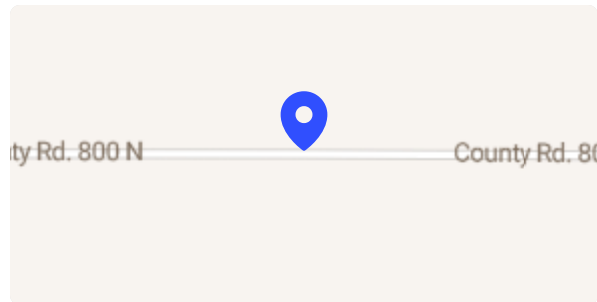

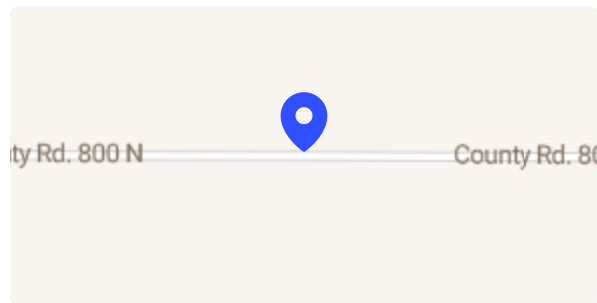
