He was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Wesley Eyman; and sister Judy Wilkerson.



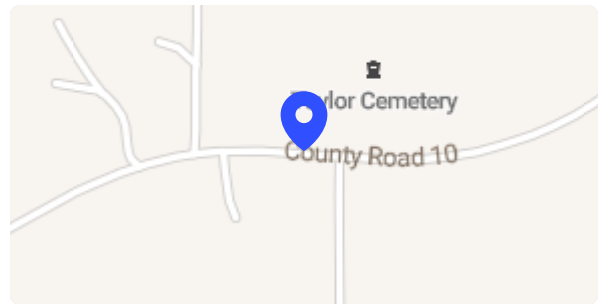

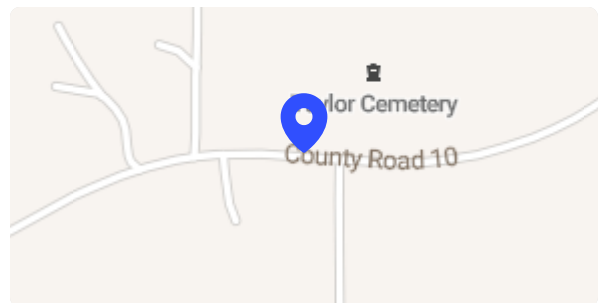
