She was preceded in death by her parents; daughters, Melissa Pruitt and Laura Pruitt; and a sister, Linda File.




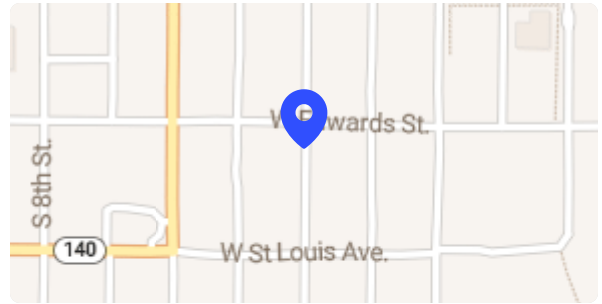
