Mr. Leidner was preceded in death by his parents and his wife.



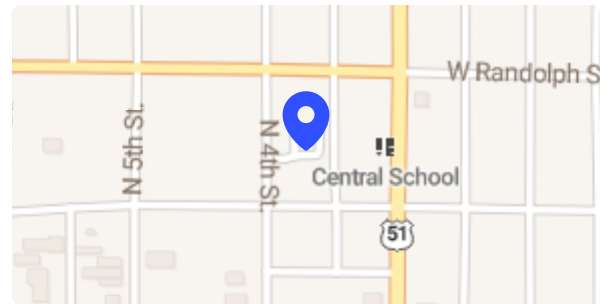

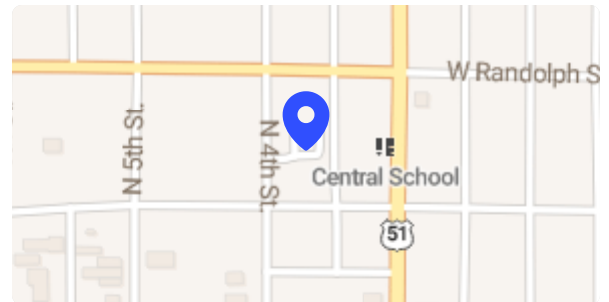

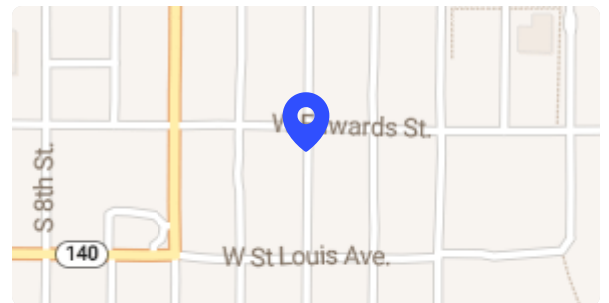
