She was preceded in death by her parents and brothers, Tommy Rubin and Freddy Rubin.



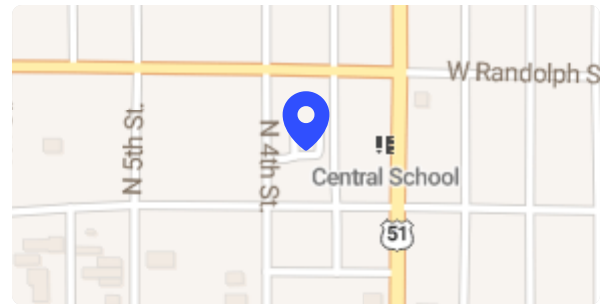

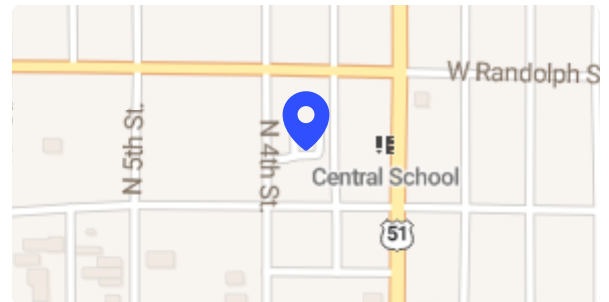

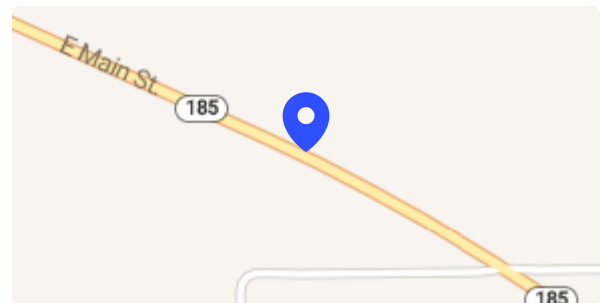
