Henry Lee Hott was born November 20, 1953 in Kansas City, MO the biological son of Henry Fields and Norma (LeRette). He was adopted by Norma's husband, Clifford Hott, whom he called his father. Hank was a Veteran; serving in the United States Air Force. He was also a retired firefighter; employed by the Fort Richardson Fire Department in Alaska for 21 years. Hank was well known for his generosity. He loved hunting, fishing, motorcycle riding, and crafting; especially painting and working with ceramics. He was a member of The Gold Wing Road Riders Association (GWRRA); the world's largest single-marque social organization for owners and riders of Honda Gold Wing/Valkyrie motorcycles.
